The Active Mobilisation System (AMS) mobilises patients continuously and barely perceptibly.



The AMS is an effective support for the prevention and treatment of pressure ulcers with a view to avoiding injury or reducing skin damage.


It provides the care staff with an effective and well accepted offloading alternative particularly for patients that have difficulty with regular turning protocolls (such as in the case of dementia, pain, agitation or aggression).


